What is the *Point-In-Time Count*?

Each January, in every county across the nation, a Point-In-Time (PIT) Count is conducted where volunteers work together to identify how many are homeless in our community. The PIT Count allows Federal and State funding to come into our community to help end homelessness.

You can help this year by volunteering just 3 hours of your time between 8am and 8pm. It's easy and fun!

Complete training and all supplies are provided, along with snacks & drinks and the satisfaction of knowing you are helping put an end to homelessness in our community. Volunteer opportunities include interviewing homeless households, homeless advocacy and entering survey data.
